

why attend our winter program?

fees.

Tuition: EUR 1,990*

The winter program fee does not include airfare, visa, housing or any personal expenses such as meals.

* partner institutions: depending on bilateral agreement, exemption from tuition fees may be granted

housing.

Housing is not included in the winter program package, but MCI will assist participants to find housing in Innsbruck for the duration of the program, usually in a student dorm. Estimated cost EUR 480.

visa.

Students from certain countries require a visa for entering Austria. MCI will provide students with information on visa requirements.

why come to innsbruck?

MCI is situated in the beautiful city of Innsbruck, in the hub of the Alps. Innsbruck offers exciting sports and leisure opportunities in winter such as skiing, ice skating, sledging or simply going for a relaxed stroll along the river Inn. There are several shopping malls in or close to the city center, museums, bars, cafés, and movie theaters that show films in English. Due to its location in central Europe, Innsbruck makes it easy to visit nearby cities and other countries – all it takes is a few-hours' train ride to:

- Salzburg, where Mozart used to live and "The Sound of Music" was filmed
- Vienna, Austria's gorgeous capital city with its rich imperial past
- Munich, city of the "Oktoberfest"
