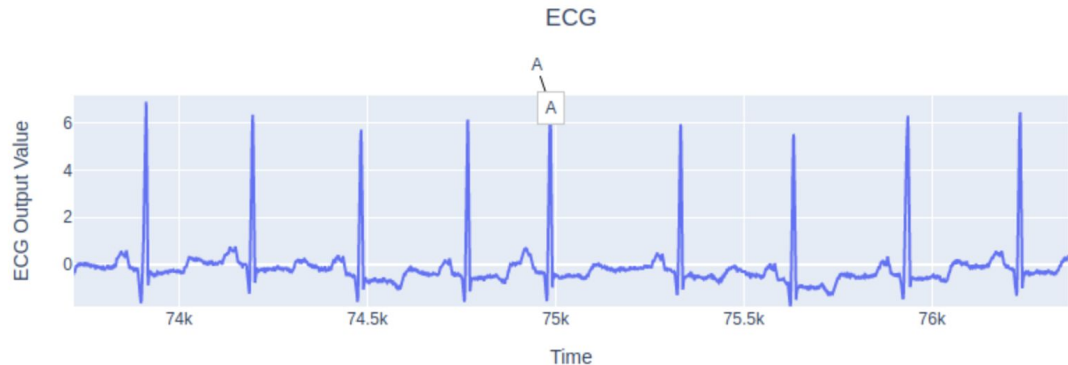

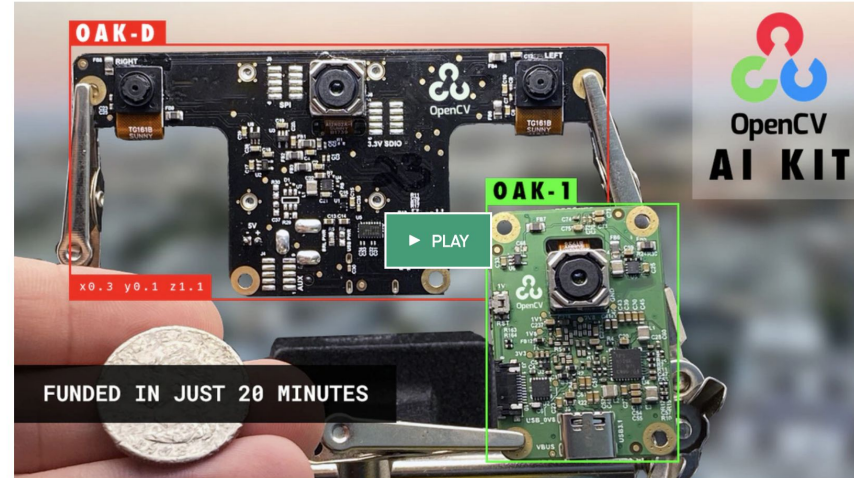
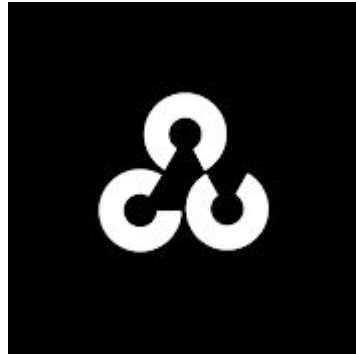
ECG Arrhythmia classification using CNN
