APPLICATION AND ENROLMENT PROCESS

Nomination process	Coordinator of a partner university fills the online application out that includes the information about the nominated student. If you have several candidates, you should fill out the form for each student.
Nomination deadlines	Fall semester – April 30 Spring semester - September 30
Application process	Student receives a welcome letter from internationalnn@hse.ru with an invitation to fill out an online student form and attach scans of the essential documents.

	After all the documents are submitted, a student will receive a letter of acceptance.
Application deadlines	Fall semester – May 15 Spring semester - October 15
Visa (if necessary)	HSE University in Nizhny Novgorod provides visa support for international students. A formal invitation from the HSE is required to get a student visa. Initially, a 90-day single-entry visa will be given to a student, which will then be extended for the whole period of exchange. More information: https://nnov.hse.ru/en/intnn/migration
