Dear Colleagues!

It is our pleasure to invite you to take part in the **IXth International Cognitive Linguistics Congress** hosted by the Nizhny Novgorod campus of the National Research University Higher School of Economics on **May 16-18, 2019** (Nizhny Novgorod, Russia).

The aim of the Congress is to discuss current problems and achievements in research of language and mind interaction from cognitive and interdisciplinary perspectives. The Congress is expected to foster further development of Cognitive Linguistics in Russia and establishment of interdisciplinary academic ties.

The discussion at the Congress will focus on the following issues:

- Theoretical and methodological problems of Cognitive Linguistics and the anthropocentric research paradigm
- Conceptualization and categorization of the world by means of language from a psycholinguistic, linguocultural and communicative perspectives
- Cognitive research into lexis and grammar
- Corpus-based research (databases) as part of the cognitive analysis of language and speech
- Computer technologies and cognitive modelling
- Cognitive analysis of text and various types of discourse
- Cognitive Sociolinguistics
- Cognitive foundations of translation
- Cognitive Linguistics and interdisciplinary research
- Cognitive Linguistics and neurolinguistic research
- Cognitive discursive approach to the analysis of culture

The working languages of the Congress are Russian, English and German.

The Congress will be organized in the form of plenary sessions and panels, lectures by the leading Russian and international researchers, round tables, presentations by PhD students. Prominent Russian and international scholars will take part in the Congress (information about the Programme Committee and Organizing Committee as well as keynote speakers can be found on the website of the Congress: nnov.hse.ru/cogling_2019).

The file containing your application for participation in the Congress should have your name in Latin in the title: **ivanov_appl**

Please note that a transliteration of Russian language references from the reference list should be attached to your application file. For automatic transliteration please use the programme from the website <http://www.translit.ru>, the BGN (Board of Geographic Names) variant.

Applications and papers to be published in the Congress Proceedings should be submitted by **October 22, 2018. Early submissions will be highly appreciated.**

While preparing your materials please keep in mind that only papers addressing the problems under discussion will be included in the programme of the Congress.

After an obligatory review process undertaken by the Editorial Board the papers will be published by the time the Congress begins in the periodical of the scientific series “Cognitive Studies of Language” from the list of publications recommended by the Higher Assessment Board (HEB) of the Russian Ministry of Education and Science. **Registration fee** (preparation and publication of the Congress proceedings and the programme as well as other expenses relating to the organization of the Congress) is *4000 RUB (3500 RUB for members of the Russian Cognitive Linguists Association)*. **The registration fee does not include a postal service fee for mailing the Congress Proceedings volume.** Payment details will be sent to the authors **after their papers have been accepted by the Editorial Board.**

Congress participants are expected to make their own travel and accommodation arrangements.

FORMATTING REQUIREMENTS FOR PAPERS

Your papers prepared for publication **should not exceed 4** pages in length in Microsoft Word format, version 6.0 and higher, Times New Roman Cyr font, size 14pt, single spaced, aligned by width. First line indent should be automatically set at 10 mm; all margins should be set at 20mm. Line spacing between paragraphs is not allowed. Double spacing is not allowed in the text. The author's name and surname should be *indicated in bold and italics* in the right-hand corner; city and country are written *in italics* in brackets; the name of the paper should be written in CAPITAL letters and in bold and centered.
